71-6: Eaglerock Premium Scaffold

Eaglerock scaffolds have a 1,000 lb/ 455kg load capacity; meet or exceed OSHA and ANSI standards; have a durable powdercoat finish and a Life Time Guarantee on all frame components.

Each Eaglerock scaffold comes with two trusses and two ladders, four 5" all-locking casters and a 3/4" fir plywood deck - 20% thicker than the industry standard of 5/8". Eaglerock decks are trimmed with 1/8" thick aluminum angle to increase their strength and durability. Eaglerock scaffolds may be stacked up to three units high (depending on regional regulation), allowing secure access to a working height of 24-26'. All jurisdictions require the use of outriggers and guardrails when stacking units.

71-8: 8' Scaffold: 5" All-Lock Casters & 3/4" Deck. This unit is the same as the one shown with the exception that it is 8' long where the 71-6 is 6' long. Both units are 6' tall.

72-6 & 72-8 are typically used in conjunction with the 71-6 & 71-8 respectively. The 72 series is stacked on top of the 71 series providing a combined platform height of 10'. The 72 series does not include casters.

Eaglerock scaffolds and components are compatible with other quality brands of scaffolds.

Eaglerock scaffolds stack one on top of another to a maximum of 3 stages, or units, high. When stacking scaffolds, guardrails, outriggers and kick boards must be used. If you are planning to use only the top platform for work access, you must still use the platforms of each preceding stage. Without them, you would lose your structural integrity on the diagonal resulting in an unstable configuration.

Note that the outriggers illustrated here have casters under them. You would take the casters from the second stacked unit and put them under the outriggers. The only time it is necessary to purchase an additional set of casters when stacking units is when you put a half stack unit, part #: 72-6 or 72-8, on a regular scaffold. Half stack units do not come with casters.

While most Eaglerock components may be used with other compatible scaffold components, outriggers may not. Nor may other manufacturer's outriggers be used with an Eaglerock system.
